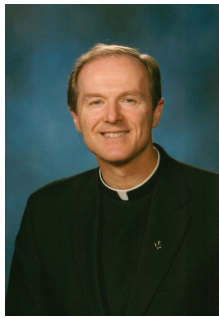

FROM THE PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

1. LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. Catholics who are **ages 18 to 59** are obliged to fast, that is, take only one full meal and two lesser meals, with nothing to eat in between meals. Drinking fluids would not be contrary to the practice of fasting.

Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstaining from meat. All Catholics who are **14 years of age and older** are obliged to abstain from eating meat.

2. SEASON OF LENT: Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent, and I will offer three Masses: 6:30 AM, 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. Mass. I want to encourage all parishioners to come to Mass that day to receive the blessed ashes, as a sign of our repentance.

3. I sincerely wish to thank Sr. Barbara Croom and the many parishioners who helped to arrange for Deacon Alex Jone's mission to Holy Savior Parish. His love for the Eucharist and early Church worship pushed him toward embracing the Catholic Faith. The mission was very inspirational and made one reflect more deeply upon our own individual faith journey. The attendance the first night was 132, and the attendance the second night was 152. (We had to send the bulletin on Wednesday morning. Therefore the attendance on Wednesday and Thursday night were not available.) I know that everyone who was able to

attend was filled with a deeper sense of peace and joy. I believe this peace and joy, because it is of the Spirit (Gal. 2:22), will only deepen and wish to be spread to others.

4. I want to invite all of those who volunteer their services to come to a special celebration just before we begin the season of Lent. I hope you will come to the Historical Peter Claver Complex on Tues, Feb 16, beginning at 6:30 PM for an evening of food and fun. Please come!!!
