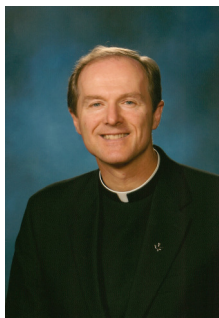

2. NOVENA FOR PENTECOST

On May 23 we celebrate Pentecost Sunday. The church began with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. Mary and Christ's disciples prayed the very first Novena for nine days in the Upper Room. We will pray the Novena to the Holy Spirit following each Mass beginning Friday, May 14. For those who can't attend the daily Mass and the Novena, you may join in praying the Novena by using the following prayers for the Novena days of prayer:

a.) Almighty and eternal God, who has vouchsafed to regenerate us by water and the Holy Spirit, and has given us forgiveness of all sins,

vouchsafe to hold send forth from heaven upon us Your sevenfold Spirit, the Spirit of Wisdom and Understanding, the Spirit of Counsel and Fortitude, the Spirit of Knowledge and Piety, and fill us with the Spirit of Holy Fear. Amen.

b.) Our Father and Hail Mary (once)

c.) Glory be to the Father (seven times).
