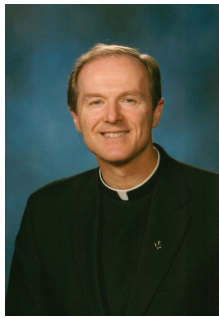

STEWARDSHIP:

The readings for today speak to us of God's gift of forgiveness given in response to our sins. In the first reading we hear That David, anointed by God To be king of Israel, fell into sin, was Forgiven, but had to suffer punishment for the sin. The reading from Paul's letter to the Galatians clarifies that there is no ritualistic code of conduct that we must follow, but only through faith in the risen Christ will be justified. In the gospel Jesus shows how faith can lead to forgiveness. While in the house of a Pharisee a woman washed Jesus' feet with her tears and Jesus forgave her sins and told her that her faith had saved her. May our faith in Christ be strong enough to accept his forgiveness.
