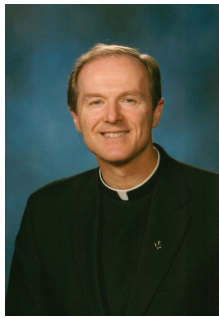

Dear Parishioners,

1. MASS SCHEDULE

Please note there will be no Mass on Monday, August 2, Friday, August 6, and Saturday, August 7 at Holy Savior Church because I will be in Colorado with the Youth. Blessed Sacrament is nearby and offers a daily 8:00 AM Mass on these days.

2. PLEASE VOTE IN THE PRIMARY

On August 3, citizens of Kansas will have an opportunity to vote in the Primary Election, an election that will have important consequences for the future of our state. I will be in Colorado with the youth group, but I, and all the adults on the trip, have made plans to cast an absentee ballot. Please take the time to exercise your important duty to vote.
