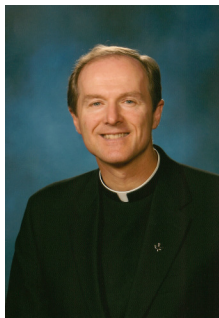

FROM THE PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

1. STRENGTHENING FAMILIES

Sherri R. Thompson McDaniel, a parishioner of Holy Savior and coordinator at The Center for Health and Wellness is sponsoring a special program for families and children ages 8 through 16. This program is designed to help parents more effectively interact and communicate with their children and help children and youth work through the challenges of peer pressure. This program builds on family strengths, encourages appreciation for one another, and decreases risky adolescent behavior. I highly recommend this program to any family. The program takes place on Thursday evenings at the Health and Wellness Center, and a meal is served to the families who participate in this program.
